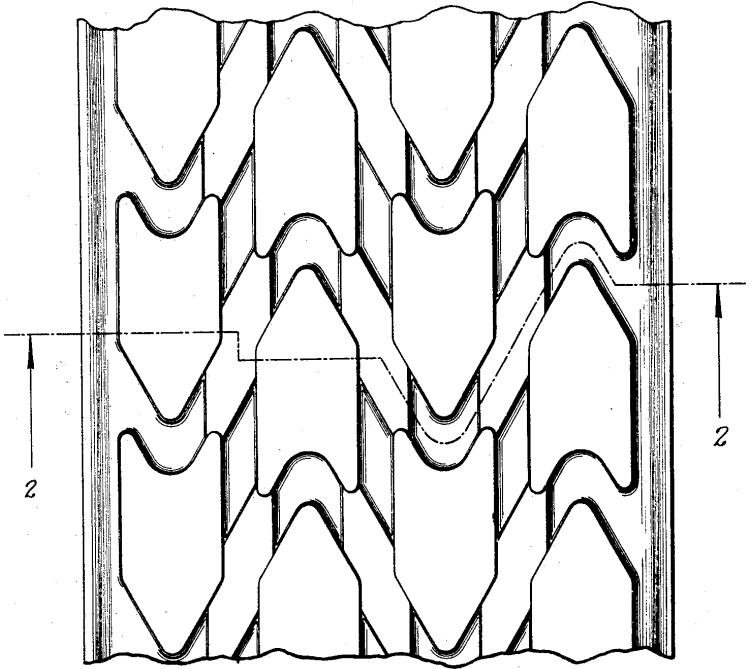

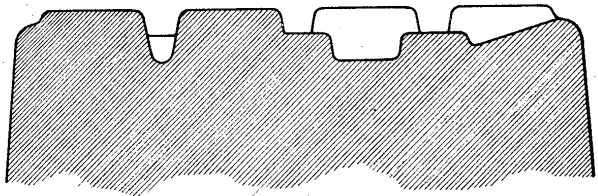

DESIGN FOR A TIRE

Application filed April 27, 1928. Serial No. 26,479. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, RALPH H. NESMITH, a citizen of the United States, residing at Grosse Pointe Park, county of Wayne, State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tires, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein:

Figure 1 is a plan view of a portion of a tire showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view of a section of a tire on the line 2—2 of Figure 1.
